


# ITWeb's 2020 Cloud Survey



#### About the survey



#### **Rank your key business objectives** (from 1 to 5, where 1 = least important; 5 = most important)









If you are currently using infrastructure cloud services, what services are you using?







The AWS Africa (Cape Town) Region launched in April 2020. Will this AWS region have any impact on your organisation's ability to meet its key objectives?






What factors hinder you from meeting your key objectives through the adoption of cloud technologies?

8% No concerns


Which cloud service model do you see as the most suitable for your organisation?
